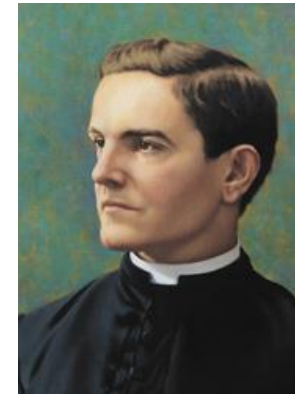

## A Memo from your K of C Insurance Agent

### 'Right to Apply' Helps Widows in Need

The laws and rules of our Order, as well as state (provincial) laws, specify that the Knights of Columbus may accept insurance applications only from Knights of Columbus members. As a member, you may apply for insurance on yourself, your wife and your dependent, minor children.

The Order's Board of Directors has taken action, though, to assure that a brother Knight's widow maintains the right to purchase additional insurance for a limited time. This can be of great benefit and comfort to those we leave behind.

This "right to apply" is available only to the widows of insured members. If a member has not availed himself of our top-rated life insurance program, or purchased an annuity or long-term care policy, this benefit is not available to his widow.

But if the Knight was an insured member, his widow has the right to apply for additional insurance on her life and on the lives of the member's minor children. This right can be exercised for up to one year following the Order's receipt of proof of the insured's death.

Know two things. First, I'll assist your widow and children in any way possible if you should die, both with your Knights of Columbus insurance and any other life insurance you may have. Second, I'll provide them my best professional advice and service to ensure that they continue to have adequate insurance protection.

As a professional agent and a brother Knight, I have no greater responsibility.

## Deputy Grand Knight's Message

Brother Knights,

I've been reading the Acts of the Apostles lately; the chapters where Peter, Paul, Barnabas and Mark are travelling to spread the "good news" about Jesus to the Jews and more significantly, for you and me, to the Gentiles. It's wonderful how God blessed the Gentiles with the gift of the Holy Spirit even though they were not following the Jewish "rules" (for example: circumcision). There was a huge discussion about whether all converts to the "Way" (ie Christianity) needed to be circumcised. Eventually, Peter won over the apostles and the disciples to God's direction that this was not necessary, as evidenced by the Holy Spirit being bestowed on the Roman Centurion Cornelius and his family without the Jewish "Rules" being followed.

How often do we throw up barriers when we see others that are not like us – race, colour, age, infirmity, gender, education, religion etc, instead of accepting them as part of the body of Christ and trying to figure out why God has put them in our path? Are we supposed to walk with them, help them, or learn from them or what? We need to pray frequently to understand God's will for us, as in the Lord's Prayer "thy will be done". It's wonderful to let God direct our lives, to trust and fully believe that He will lead us where we can be of best use to His plan.

Today, my wife and I returned from 2 weeks in Kingston – what a wonderful community, much like Sudbury. St Paul's is much like Holy Redeemer – vibrant, so full of God's Spirit, a great music ministry, a very active K of C Council etc. Before we started for home, we said a prayer for God to direct our safe trip home and offered ourselves to Him....we went about 45 km west on the 401 and stopped. It was closed due to an earlier fatality. Just as we slowed down, I noticed the exit for Hwy 41 North. We took it and had a wonderful, interesting and safe trip (hardly any traffic) back to Sudbury through Pembroke, Mattawa and North Bay. Thanks be to God for disclosing this new route and keeping us safe, especially in this heat.

Take some time for God this summer and let Him into your lives, no matter what you are doing. He's just a prayer call away, better than a cell phone and you know He will pick up.

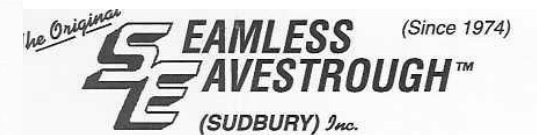
